



EDUCATIONAL GRANT APPLICATION FORM FOR INDIVIDUALS

1. Granting Opportunity

Limit: A maximum of \$1,000 per application.

The Fort St. James Community Foundation is a registered non-profit society. The Foundation fund raises annually through special events and donations to accumulate money for an endowment fund. The endowment fund is invested and interest earned on the investments are distributed to the communities in the form of grants. The benefiting area is Fort St. James and the Regional District of Bulkley Nechako Area C, including Germanson Landing, Manson Creek, First Nations communities of Nak'azdli, Tl'az'ten, Binche, Yekooche, and Takla Lake.

2. For the Educational Grants; Eligible Applicants must:

- reside in the benefitting area listed above.
- be a deserving student or adult, undertaking education at a post-secondary institution. (Universities, Technology and Trade Schools).
- be attending first, second or third year as a post-secondary student.

3. Evaluation Criteria

Applications will be evaluated for the following criteria:
Community Involvement 100% (This includes all forms of volunteerism, participation in sports, coaching, Student Council, employment, etc. over the past three years.)

Applications can be picked up hard-copy after March 1st at the District of Fort St. James Municipal Office, Fort St. James Library, Nak'azdli Band Office, Fort St. James Secondary School, and CNC.

Applications will only be reviewed if they are submitted on forms provided by the Foundation. Other application formats will not be accepted. Additional pages may be attached but the form itself must not be modified.

Payment to the successful applicant will be made when the student has provided proof of registration at the post-secondary institution. Awards may only be deferred one year. All grant recipients must submit a final report by November 31st, complete with a photo of themselves at their chosen training facility and a photo release allowing the Foundation to use their photo.
